End of Month Report – June 2016

Dear Members and Friends of the BRS School Advancement Committee:

As always, our Admission team is pleased to provide this YTD summary of activity through July 15, 2015.

We are feeling good about our present position as September 30 approaches.

I would suggest five highlights, based on the data included here:

- Through July 15, we have **134** students contracted 94 returning and 40 new.
- In addition to these, we have 24 more students who have given verbal commitments or who are highly likely to attend, bringing us to a working total of **158** against our goal of **174**.
- While our total admission funnel of inquiry continues to slowly shrink, our comparative yield from it this season remains excellent.
- Use of Financial Aid remains on track our average award to this point and our amount of dollars still available both indicate we are within planned parameters thus far.
- International enrollment is expected to entirely meet its targets in both reenrollment and new enrollment by July 31st – based on a desired domestic/international ratio of 70/30.

So...40 contracts to go!

In reality, this means confirmation of the 24 we have in process, and an additional 16 from inquiries we expect to receive in the next eight weeks or so.

Using traditional measures of activity in August and September, we should be on track to hit 174 by September 30.
